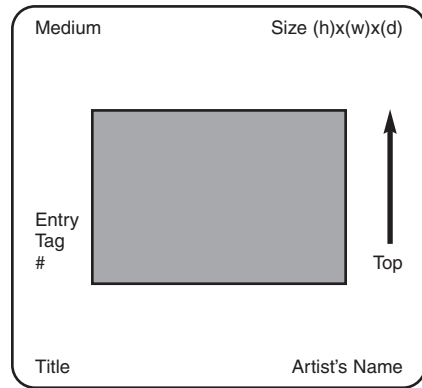


CHECKLIST FOR ENTRY

ELIGIBILITY

Artists may enter up to three pieces for consideration. Submissions should be made by actual work, but slide or video submissions will also be accepted. Slides must be received by May 27, 2004 by 4:00 p.m. Work must be original, not executed under instruction and available for exhibition if selected (no substitution). Work must have been produced within the last two years and may not have been exhibited within 150 miles of Pittsburgh in that time.

3D work

May submit second view slide; mark 1a/1b, 2a/2b, 3a/3b.

Installations

Submit up to five slides and one page typed proposal.

Time-based art or other kinetic pieces

Submit videotape of 1-5 minute duration.

Delivery if submitting actual work

Actual work may be hand delivered on June 4 or 5 from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. to 7310 Frankstown Avenue (two blocks from Braddock Avenue). Artists must pick up all work submitted on June 12 from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.

Size/weight limitations

All work should be self-contained, requiring no additional wall construction. Gallery ceilings are 17' high but all work must fit through doors 10' x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' x 8". 3D work cannot exceed 250 lbs.

ENTRY REGULATIONS

Slides must be 35mm, color and in 2"x2" cardboard or thin plastic mounts. Glass slides or slides with masking tape will not be considered. The juror will reject work that does not conform to the image on the slide.

Each slide must be clearly identified on the front with medium, size, title, artist's name, entry form number and an arrow indicating top. Titles will appear in catalogue exactly as written on entry tags.

Please complete two entry tags for each piece submitted. Tape the two tags to the back left hand top or bottom corner of each piece entered.

If entering by slide, include two tags with each slide. The information on the slide must correspond with that on the entry tag. Number slide to conform with entry tag.

If work is not for sale, please be sure to indicate insurance value, along with NFS, for insurance purposes.

PROCESSING FEE

\$20.00 for AAP members current with 2004-2005 dues, \$80.00 for non-members. Artists submitting to the 94th AAP Annual Exhibition who wish to join AAP may screen for membership within one year. If accepted, 2004-2005 dues will be waived.

DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORK

Artists are responsible for delivery of all accepted work to the Regina Gouger Miller Gallery.
